



Record of Road Test

Complete the following Road Test placing a check mark in each section, indicating successful completion. A qualified SIRVA driver must give this Road Test. Note to examiner: A copy of the Road Test and Certification must be furnished to the applicant upon successful completion of this exam.

1. Pre-Trip Inspection
(Fully understands pre-trip inspection)

Checks around unit - tires, lights, trailer hookup, brake and light lines, coupling device, body, doors, horn, and windshield wipers.
Tests steering mechanism, brake action, tractor protection valve, and parking (hand) brake.
Cleans windshield, windows, mirrors, lights, and reflectors.
Checks instruments.

2. Coupling And Uncoupling
(Check only if Tractor-Trailer)

Lines up unit, keeps brake and electric lines clear, secures trailer, backs slowly, checks hook-ups, hits pin, handles landing gear properly, secures power unit.

3. Placing Vehicle In Motion

Checks air pressure and instruments, parking brake applied disengages clutch, warms up engine, secures seat belts, proper gear selection, checks traffic, shift gears smoothly.

4. Use of Vehicle's Controls and Emergency Equipment

Clutch and transmission, brakes steering, lights, jacks, tools, tire chains, wheel chocks, emergency warning devices, fire extinguisher.

5. Operating The Vehicle in Traffic And While Passing Other Vehicles

Leaving curb, speed control, smoothness of operation, shifting gears, anticipates traffic problems, obeys traffic laws, signals properly, allows sufficient passing room, passes carefully and smoothly, uses mirrors.

6. Turning The Vehicle

Signals well in advance turns from proper lane, looks all around before turning, (protect blind side), turns at proper speed, turns into proper lane, yields right-of-way.

7. Braking And Slowing The Vehicle By Means Other Than Braking

Signals, checks mirrors, smoothness of application, proper use of tractor protection valve, uses engine to reduce speed by shifting to lower gear.

8. Backing And Parking Vehicle

Gets out and checks, sounds horn when necessary, avoids backing to blind side, backs slowly, checking mirrors, parks clear of traveled surface, used guide and prearranged signals if necessary, secure unit properly.
